

To all applicants:

The Scholarship Committee of the Women's Welsh Clubs of America is pleased to receive your application request for its scholarship. We are anxious to grant as many scholarships as possible to students of Welsh descent, spouse of a person of Welsh ancestry, or legally adopted descendent of a Welsh person.

Please read the enclosed *Guide for Scholarships* very carefully. Note especially the deadline date of July 15th for receipt of the scholarship applications and transcripts. Should July 15th fall on a Saturday or a Sunday, the application and transcripts must be received by the previous Friday.

We strongly advise you to follow up your request to the registrar to confirm and follow up that your transcripts will arrive prior to July 15th. Your application will be invalid if transcripts are not received.

The Scholarship Committee will review your application and transcripts the next business day after July 15th. The first half of your award will be mailed by the end of August. The second half of your award will be mailed in February after receiving your transcripts confirming a 3.00 GPA directly from the college following the fall quarter/semester.

COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION

At a time when cost of higher education is increasing, the Women's Welsh Clubs of America want to assist qualified and deserving students of Welsh descent in attaining their education and career goals through a scholarship program.

Therefore, in 1997 the Women's Welsh Clubs of America established a scholarship program funded by a portion of the income from its Endowment Fund and the monies earned and contributed each year by the individual clubs making up the Women's Welsh Clubs of America. Gifts to the Endowment Fund are invited so that the funds for scholarships will be increased.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants for scholarships must be of Welsh descent, or the spouse or legally adopted descendent of a person of Welsh descent, a citizen of the United States, and meet all of the following requirements:

- 1) Have and maintain an unadjusted accumulated grade point average of not less than 3.00 on a 4.00 scale or the equivalent and
- 2.) Declare enrollment as a full time student, or if employed, as a part time student or doing post-baccalaureate studies leading to a degree in an institution of higher learning qualified to award such a degree, and
- 3) Authorize the registrar of the school to send an official transcript of applicant's academic record to the Scholarship Committee, and

4) Such other requirements as may be determined by the Scholarship Committee from time to time with the approval of the Board of Trustees.

An applicant must be a high school graduate and have maintained an accumulated unadjusted 3.00 grade point average or the equivalent.

Completed applications must be returned to the above address by July 15th of each year. Incomplete applications or applications received after July 15th will not be considered.

SCHOLARSHIP AID

Both the number of scholarships granted each year and the actual amount of individual scholarships are dependent upon funds available.

The size of the grants will be determined by the Scholarship Committee and the Trustees of the Women's Welsh Clubs of America, as will eligibility for more than one year of aid and also post baccalaureate university studies.

Grants will be paid directly to the successful applicant in installments for each term of the academic year, provided the applicant maintains the required eligibility. The recipient must authorize the registrar of the school to send an official transcript of the student's academic record to the Scholarship Committee at the end of each term.
